

# Ofsted – Briefings for Headteachers and Governors (Autumn 2017)

**Are you due an Ofsted inspection? Have you ever led a school through an inspection, or done so in recent years?**

These briefings are aimed at supporting all headteachers and governors in schools across all phases. Experience indicates that how senior leaders ‘manage’ the inspection process is crucial to achieving a successful outcome. The greatest benefit from the briefings will be gained if a Headteacher and a governor, usually the Chair, attend together. The briefings will clearly explain expectations of the Common Inspection Framework for both section 8 and section 5 inspections, provide handy tips to take back, an opportunity hear first hand from headteachers who have recently undergone an inspection and to ask questions.

## Course Outline

The briefing will cover key aspects and provide up to date information regarding what you can expect before, during and after an inspection. The session will cover:

- managing ‘short inspections’ and full ‘section 5’ inspections
- firsthand insights from headteachers who have recently experienced inspections resulting in varying outcomes
- additional thoughts plus questions and answers
- the Hampshire picture
- useful and essential documents

Within each session the content will be appropriate for all phases with references being made to aspects relating to specific phases where appropriate. The content will also be covered with a view to the implications for both professionals and governors.
